

INTEGRATED FACTSHEET PRODUCTION (IFP)

IFP is based on the Flux framework and provides a whole new way to produce PDF factsheets. There are no templates, no layout per product and the like. With Flux IFP you configure rules which define what has to be displayed under what circumstances where and how. Even if you produce thousands of factsheets in a great diversity you only need a single document configuration. The document tree together with the graphical editor and the 100% WYSIWYG preview gives you full control over the document layouts at any time.

With FLUX IFP you can easily setup single page, multi page documents and even books. For Books table of content, page numbers, section markers and other book specific functions are available. Some layout building blocks do not only support dynamic layouts but they also can, based on rules, optimize the layout.

- Highly configurable building blocks for all sort of layout elements like text, tables, charts, columns, grid layout and so on
- Validation functionality to even check colour spaces, page overflows and similar aspects
- Support for footnotes and text references
- Support for crop marks and bleed
- CSS based styling
- Configuration analysis
- Packages and deployment environments supporting change management
- Fully customizable batch system
- Custom building block libraries via the FLUX plug-in architecture

The function range and integration options fulfil even the demanding requirements for the factsheet production at Credit Suisse. Credit Suisse produces every month for about 800 products over 6'000 factsheets, manager reports and factbooks for 9 issuers in 20 languages for 16 countries with FLUX IFP.
